- Install, troubleshoot, and repair structured fiber optic and copper cabling systems.
- Utilize equipment for structured cabling testing, fiber splicing, and certification.
- Install cabling support above ceilings.
- Assemble and install cable tray and head end closet build outs.
- Analyze schematics, prints, or drawings for the purpose of installing structured cabling systems.
- Lead/manage team members.
- Manage installation and communicate verbally and in writing with CooperCraft management and customers.
- Work from a ladder, scaffolding, and/or lift equipment.
- Lift/move equipment and tools weighing up to 100 pounds.
- Utilize experience and/or training certifications to effectively install structured cabling systems.
